# INTRODUCTION

The primary reason for the client move to Power BI was reduced license costs but moving to the Microsoft platform did provide them some additional benefits. Consolidating their software tools to a single vendor simplifies maintenance and promotes cross tool collaboration. It also gives them access to the Power Platform that they can leverage to automate more of their business processes.

# CHALLENGES

The client wished to migrate to Power BI in a short timescale to complete the migration before their license renewal date. However, they only have a small in-house BI team that needs to focus on BAU reporting. Hence they reached out to Peraison, a Microsoft partner with extensive experience of migrating reporting platforms to Power BI.

The migration also had some technical challenges:

- Complex ETL processes based upon QVD storage.
- nPrinting used extensively to generate PDF reports to email to stakeholders.
